Arrival

- 8:10-8:25 Drop off in Harrison Avenue parking lot.
- Right turn only out of parking lot.
- Do not drop off directly on Harrison Avenue.
- Students walk through the gate on Harrison.
- After 8:25, they are late and need to be brought to the front of the school and walked inside the office.



Dismissal

- We will dismiss from the Harrison Avenue parking lot by 2:50 pm.
- Do not pick up directly on Harrison Avenue.
- Students will be sorted in two groups: WALKERS or RIDERS.
- WALKERS will be escorted out the KINDER gate. Please wait off to the side as we come through. You may take your child when you see him/her. If you do not see your child, proceed to the fence along the sidewalk.
- RIDERS will be escorted out the larger gate and seated by the fence along the sidewalk.
- Do not park or get out of your car.
- Kids need to learn to buckle themselves.
